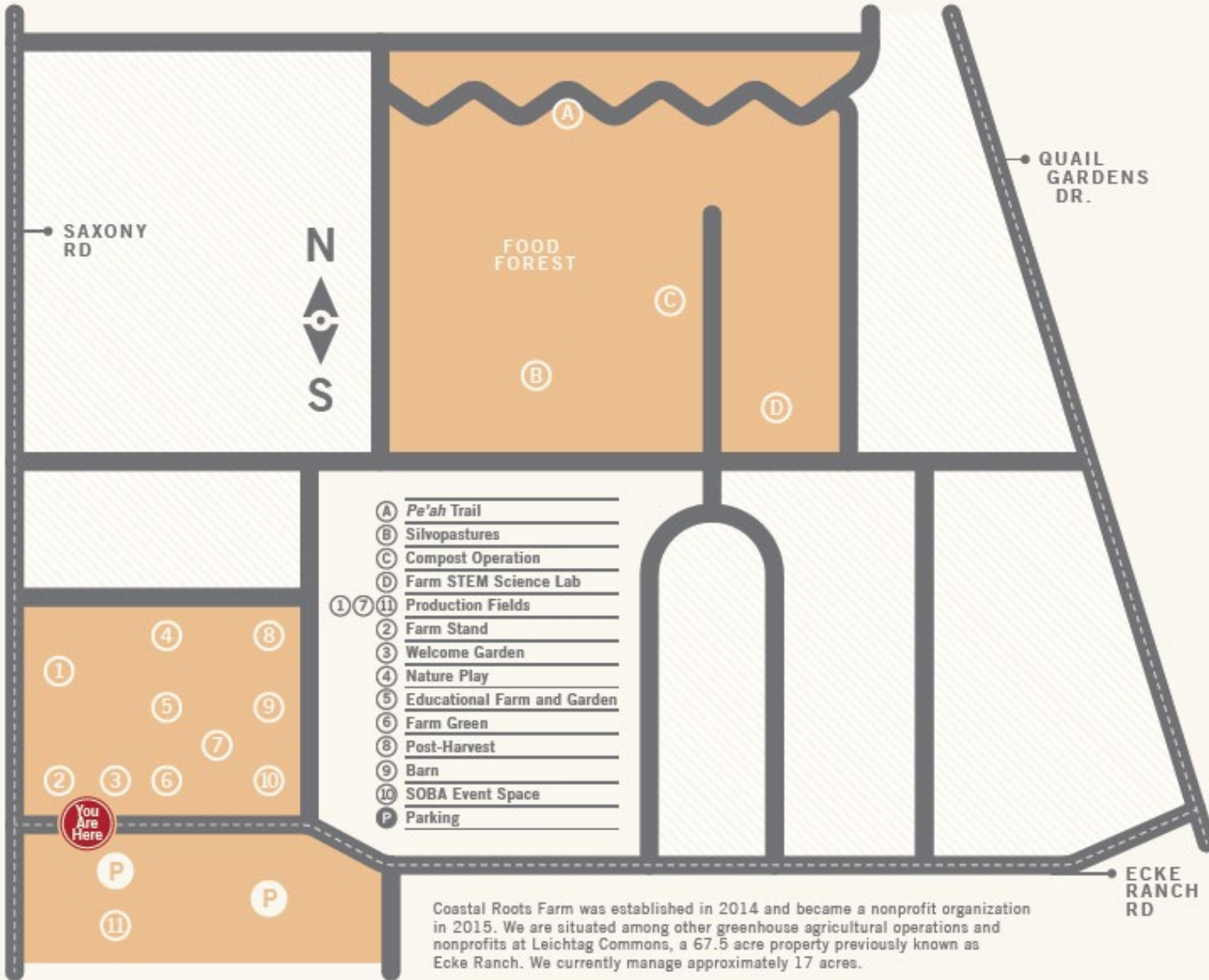


We are located in Encinitas, CA at Leichtag Commons, a 67.5 acre property previously known as Ecker Ranch.

The Farm was established in 2014 and became a nonprofit in December 2015.

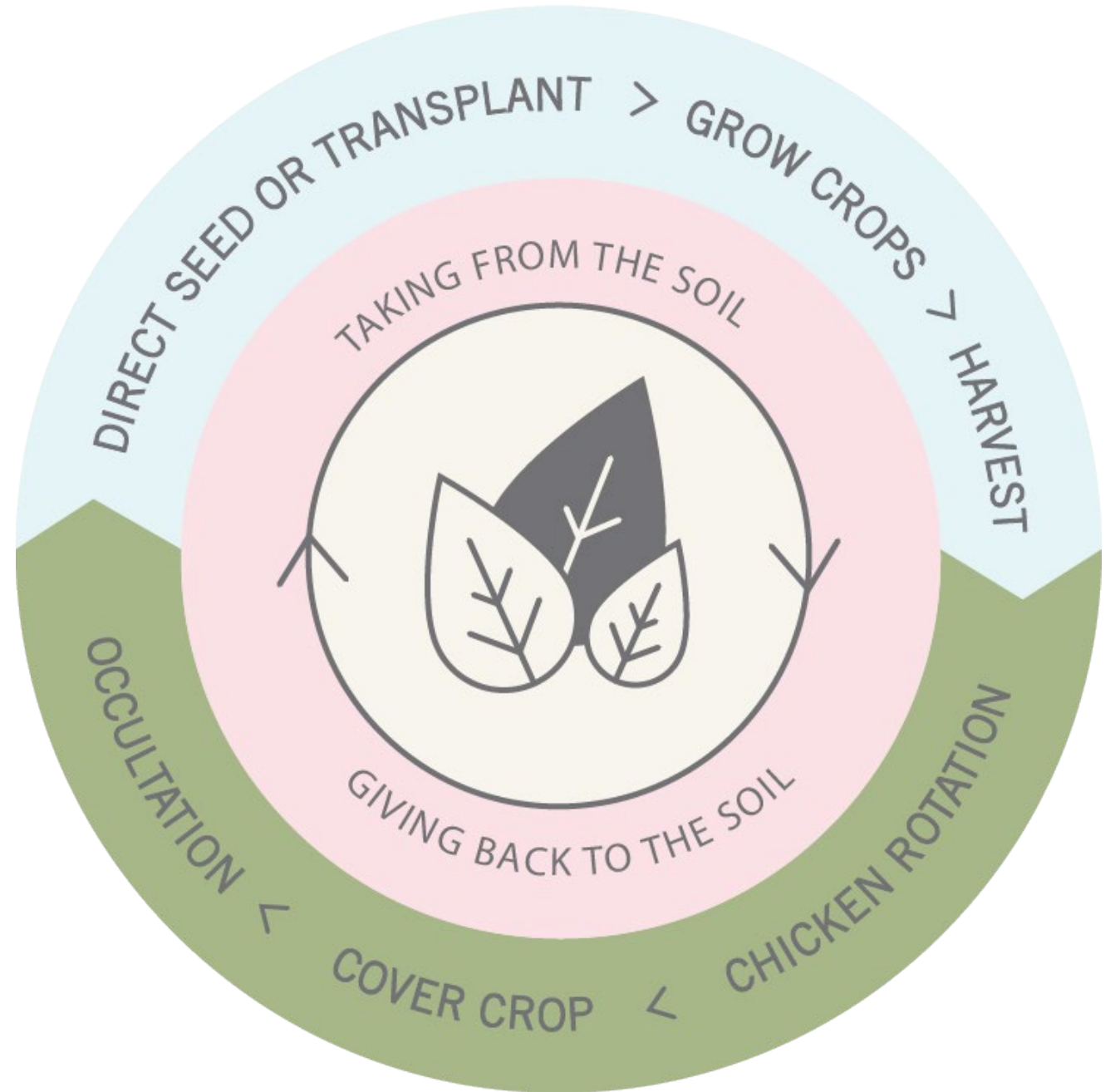
